



# Practical

## Standard Visit

Below you will find one or two practical tips in connection with your Standard Visit reservation.

Please read these through carefully, so that we can offer you an unforgettable brewery experience.

1. Bear in mind that you are visiting an industrial site with lots of stairs and steps and possibly smooth floors. The brewery is therefore difficult to access for wheelchairs and prams. The bottling plant can only be accessed by stairs.

**TIP:** Wear appropriate footwear: high heels are not recommended.

2. You can arrive at Duvel Depot, Breendonkdorp 66, Puurs **15 minutes** before the start of the visit. At that point, the guide will open the black entrance door. Please bring your confirmation e-mail containing your reservation number with you.
3. Parking is available on the public road on Buisseretlaan, in all adjacent streets and in the car park of the Vrijhals sports centre on Cyriel Verschaevestraat 15 in Puurs (a 5 minute walk).
4. Coaches must also park there. Buses can only let passengers alight at the authorised parking points. For safety reasons, passengers may not therefore be let down at the entrance.
5. The local residents kindly ask that you turn your engines off.
6. From 6 p.m., the car park with the barriers of Duvel Moortgat on Pastoor Somerslaan can also be used by brewery visitors. If you are parked there, please inform the guide so that he or she can give you a code to allow you to exit the car park after your visit.
7. There is a bus connection from Puurs station:  
Bus 250 goes from Puurs Station to the stop by the brewery: 'Gemeentehuis'.
